

# ROUTE #7. BLUE MEDITERRANEAN Natural Park of la Albufera and Cullera







### **DESCRIPTION**



This is an easy, peaceful and very beautiful road bike route, passing through the marvelous Natural Park of La Albufera and the nice coast of Valencia. We start from the city of the Arts and Sciences towards the South. We go through El Saler, always parallel to the coastline. We find La Albufera between pine trees and rice paddies and the natural park of La Dehesa. Finally we arrive to the town of Cullera to enjoy wonderful views of the entire Bay of Valencia

## CULTURAL AND TOURIST PLACES
